The Paphos Theatre Archaeological Project is the University of Sydney's major archaeological excavation in Cyprus, at the World Heritage listed site of Nea Paphos.

Since 1995 the team of Australian archaeologists have worked with the Department of Antiquities of Cyprus uncovering and studying the remains of the ancient theatre used for performance for more than six centuries between 300 BC and 365 AD. As well as being a major research project, the excavation has provided training for hundreds of Australian university students. Your support will help the excavations and research continue. Our unofficial mascots are two Roman marble relief griffins of the second century AD.

	Victorian Premier Chardonnay Pinot Noir Sparkling NV A terrific fizz offering up apple and stonefruit scents and some fresh bready notes. It's rich on the palate with baked apple and peachy flavours and a tangy, lemony dry finish.	\$18	\$216		
	Victorian Premium Pinot Grigio 2017 This is very much in the Italian style of Grigio, crisp clean and citrusy though with a pear like juiciness that offers that gives it an extra hit of flavour. A crisp, white that suits salads, seafood and sipping.	\$18	\$216		
	Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2017 This fresh, zesty white has all the distinctive aromatic qualities that made Marlborough famous and backs it up with the clean flavours of green herbs, cut grass and passionfruit juiciness filling the mouth and finishing all clean and tangy.	\$18	\$216		
	Margaret River Chardonnay 2017 A full bodied dry white from the famous Margaret River. Generous stonefruit characters are held in check by a streak of citrusy acidity and some subtle vanilla notes. 	Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2017 The Coonawarra regionality comes to the fore distinct blackcurrant and cherry edged fruit given a savoury twist by a minty, gum leafy note. This character carries on to the palate and along with the ripe, fine tannins offers a framework for the fruit to sit on. Medium to full bodied on the palate with a finely woven balance of fruit, tannin, spice and oak.	\$18	\$216		
	Heathcote Reserve Shiraz 2017 Classic Australian Shiraz from the ancient Cambrian soils of Heathcote in Central Victoria. Rich and full bodied with flavours of ripe plums, blackcurrants, vanilla and cocoa leading to a long, vanilla scented and soft tanned finish.	\$18	\$216
